

## **SIGNING POLL BOOK**

There are 2 poll books, **BUT ONLY ONE POLL BOOK NEEDS TO BE SIGNED.**

The signed poll list will be returned to the County.

- (1) Each eligible voter, before receiving a serial number will state his or her full name and address and present to the inspectors a photo proof of ID.
- (2) The Inspectors will verify that the name on the photo proof presented by the voter conforms to the name on the poll list (if Robert is on the Driver's License Photo ID, but Bob is on the poll list, this is acceptable), and the photo on the document resembles the voter.
- (3) The Inspector will then ask the voter to enter his or her signature on the County poll book list, supplemental list, or any other list maintained, unless the voter is exempt from the signature requirement (disability, etc.).
- (4) The voter should enter his/her normal signature, the way he/she normally signs. The inspector does not have to check the signature with the photo ID provided. If the voter signs with an "X" or a "straight line," and that's his/her normal signature, the inspector should accept the signature, and issue a ballot.
- (5) If the voter is exempt from a signature, the inspector shall enter next to the name and address "exempt by order of inspectors."

(6) If a voter refuses to sign the poll list ("I never had to do this before, and I voted here for 30 years," or "you know me" etc.), and does not claim to be physically disabled, the voter is not allowed to be issued a ballot by the inspectors.
