The Morgan Town Board meets the second Monday of each month at 7:00 PM in the Town Hall. All meetings are open to the public. Anyone wishing to bring an item to the Board's attention, please request first that it be placed on the monthly Town Board agenda. Please contact the Chairman or Clerk to be placed on the agenda.

The Land Use committee meets the last Monday of each month at 7:00 in the Town Hall.

All dogs that are found should be reported to Nikki Coopman. Dogs should **not** be dropped off at Oconto County Humane Society. A \$20 fee will be charged when returning a lost dog to its owner.

Deputy Zoning Administrator should be contacted when you are doing construction or tearing down any buildings. Inspections are required on new dwellings.

The Town Board must be contacted prior to **ANY** work being done in the Town right-of-way along any Town roads. This includes brush cutting, digging, and culvert and driveway installation.

Burning Permits can be obtained from Ron Korzeniewski, William Montgomery, or Gordon Aprill.

Recycling Center hours are each Saturday, 8:15 AM to 12:15 PM. G & S Refuse, Inc. is the contract garbage and recycling hauler for the Town of Morgan. Recycling brochures are available from the Recycle Center attendants.

The Town Hall is available for rent with for \$75 (\$40 security deposit plus \$35 fee). Please contact Chairman, Fran Wranosky.
