

**BEGINNING IN 2012, THE TOWN OF MORGAN HAS TWO WARDS  
AND TWO SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS**

**Ward 1 -- Supervisory District 7**

**Part of the Town of Chase and part of the Town of Morgan**

Beginning at the intersection of State Highway 32 and County Rd. S, thence north along State Highway 32 to the north line of the Town of Morgan, thence east along said north line to County Rd. C, thence south along County Rd. C to County Rd. E, thence east along County Rd. E to Valentine Rd., thence south along Valentine Rd., and continuing south along the east line of the Town of Morgan and the east line of the Town of Chase to Lower Rd., thence west along Lower Rd. to County Rd. C, thence westerly, northerly and westerly along County Road C to Schwartz Rd., thence south along Schwartz Rd. to County Rd. S, thence west along County Rd. S to State Highway 12 and the place of beginning.

**Ward 2 -- Supervisor District 21**

**Part of the Town of Morgan and part of the Town of Oconto Falls**

Beginning at the southwest corner of the town of Oconto Falls, thence north along the west boundary line of said Town of Oconto Falls to the northwest corner of the Town of Oconto Falls, thence east on the north boundary line of the Town of Oconto Falls to County Rd. B, thence southerly along County Rd. B to Little Beaver Lake Rd., thence southerly along Little Beaver Rd. to Beaver Lake Rd., thence west on Beaver lake Rd. to Pipgrass Rd., thence south on Pipgrass Rd. to State Hwy. 22, thence east on State Hwy. 22 to Washbisch Rd., thence east and southeast along Washbisch Rd. to the boundary line of the City of Oconto Falls, thence following City of Oconto Falls boundary line in a counter-clockwise direction along the northern, western and southern boundary to the east boundary to the Town of Oconto Falls, then south along said east boundary line of Oconto Falls and continuing south along the east boundary line of the Town of Morgan to County Rd. E, thence west along County Rd. E to County Rd. C, thence north on County Rd. C to the boundary line between the Town of Morgan and the Town of Oconto Falls, thence west along said boundary line to the place of beginning.
