

Town of Morgan Ordinance 2-08-08-2016

The Town Board of the Town of Morgan, Oconto County Wisconsin does ordain to AMEND and COMBINE Town of Morgan Driveway and Culvert Ordinances 2-06-11-2012, 3-08-13-2012, and 1-08-10-2015, and ADOPT Ordinance 2-08-08-2016.

DRIVEWAY

- Landowner shall be responsible for construction of driveway, meeting Town requirements, and clean-up of debris after construction.
- Landowner installing, removing, or altering a driveway without Town Board approval shall be charged an inspection fee of \$70.00, plus cost of any repairs or corrections.
- Residential driveway shall be a minimum 20 ft. wide driving surface with a height clearing 15 ft. to accommodate emergency or other authorized vehicles (no obstructing brush or tree branches).
- Ag and commercial driveways shall be a minimum 35 ft. wide driving surface.
- Driveway markers shall be placed so as not to interfere with snowplowing, grass cutting, emergency, or other authorized vehicles.
- Landowner shall be responsible for providing access to new or existing driveways by emergency or other authorized vehicles. Clearing vegetation, snow, gates, and the like to the principal structure on property shall be responsibility of landowner.
- Town Inspector shall issue driveway permit after Town Board approval.

CULVERT


- Landowner shall be responsible for cost of culvert, meeting Town requirements, and clean-up of debris on public roads.
- Two or more members of Town Board shall determine size of all residential, ag, or commercial culverts, on a case by case basis.
- Culvert shall not be removed without Town Board approval.
- When Town road is under construction, culvert may be replaced at discretion of Town Board, paid by Town.
- Residential culvert shall be a minimum of 30 ft. long and 12-inches in diameter with end walls added to the 30 ft.
- Ag and commercial culverts shall be a minimum of 40 ft. long and 15-inches in diameter with end walls added to the 40 ft.
- Culvert shall be new and of steel or concrete construction (no other type of material allowed).
- Culvert shall be covered with pit run, or $\frac{3}{4}$ up to $1\frac{1}{4}$ aggregate/gravel. Finish cover coat shall be 6-inch cover with $\frac{3}{4}$ or $1\frac{1}{4}$ aggregate/gravel.
- After Town Board approval, Town Inspector shall issue permit, considering width of culvert only.

This Ordinance shall be effective after adoption by a majority of the Town Board of Morgan on a roll call vote, and upon publication by the Town Clerk as required under S60.80 Wis stats.
