Monday, March 8, 2021
TOWN OF MORGAN

1. **Called Board Meeting to Order.** Meeting called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman Fran Wranosky. Present: Town Clerk Julie Belongia, Treasurer Cindy Smith, Supervisor Leonard Wahl, and Supervisor Ron Korzeniewski. **Pledge of Allegiance was recited.**
2. **Approval of Agenda:** Motion made by Ron /2nd by Leonard to approve the agenda as printed. All in favor. M/C.
3. **Approved Minutes of February 8, 2021 board meeting.** Motion made by Leonard/2nd by Ron to dispense with the reading of the 2/8/21 minutes and approve as printed. All in favor. M/C.
4. **Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer reported February deposits \$125,056.70 with beginning balance of \$656,435.36. After February pay outs which total \$367,417.25. The ending balance is \$414,074.81. No motion needed for an informational report.
5. **Recycling Center-** Tires on 2 bicycles and one garden tiller have been taken away by Mikey Smet's Auto Salvage. Clerk talked with Mike directly about the tires being on the items. Need to make a sign – Remove tires from the following items and place items in the correct piles. Metal with Metal and Tires with Tires.

Town hall is open for scheduling for rentals.

Oconto County has been filling in pot holes on town roads. It was mentioned to set aside money every 3 years to replace some of the road signs that are looking bad or need to be replaced during budget time. Need to do a calculation of the number of signs in the town and what it costs for one sign. Fran will work on this.
